- Ensuring learning from deaths lead to changes in systems and practice.
- Responsible for overseeing appropriate governance in STP footprint.

CCG Lead/ Local Area Contact (LAC)

Responsible for overseeing LeDer implementation within organisation.

- With Local Authority lead oversee the establishment and implementation of local steering group.
- Responsible for allocating cases to reviewers in local CCG area.
- Responsible for ensuring that a pool of sufficient trained reviewers is maintained across organisations in local CCG area.
- Responsible for monitoring reviewer progress and ensuring timely review completion in local CCG area
- Awareness raising of LeDeR in organisation and partner organisations.
- Formulating and updating local LeDeR Action Plan.
- Have oversight of deaths notifications and learning in CCG area.

Provider Organisation Lead

- Responsible for overseeing LeDer implementation within organisation.
- Attend and support the implementation of local steering group.
- Responsible for putting forward reviewers for training and maintaining a sufficient pool of trained reviewers within the organisation.
- Responsible for ensuring that reviewers within organisation are afforded sufficient time to complete reviews.
- Responsible for ensuring a protocol is in place to enable access to case notes for LeDeR reviewers from outside organisations when requested.
- Awareness raising of LeDeR in organisation and partner organisations.
- Formulating and updating local LeDer Action Plan.
